Updated Strategic and Operational Plan Documents

Boards of Education are required to develop and implement multi-year strategic plans. The Board of Education of School District No. 59 (PRS) identified three priorities for the 2020-2024 Strategic Plan: Equity, Foundations Skills and Core Competencies, and Sustainable Use of Our Resources. The Operational Plan was recently completed and outlines how the main priorities of the Strategic Plan will be carried out including evaluation criteria and timelines.
